

## Progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2

**3 levels of progress (better than expected)	33% (30)	27% (20)	77% (60)

<sup>\*</sup>An average child attains a level 2 at the end of Key stage 1 in Year 2. By the time they reach the end of Year 6 (Key Stage 2) an average child is expected to attain a level 4. This is 2 levels of progress, as is level 3 (KS1) to level 5 (KS2) and level 1 (KS1) to level 3(KS2). This is expected progress.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Sometimes pupils attain a level 2 in Year 2 and a level 5 in Year 6 – this is 3 levels of progress (as is level 1 to level 4 and level 3 to level 6). This is better than expected progress.
