He said ' I really like looking after the fish as I think it is important to look after animals. Also, I think maybe I want to be a vet when I am older so this helps me'

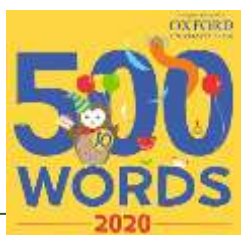
Thank you to Michael's mum, Mrs. Yiallouris, for buying the school 2 new fish (Rico and Spot) who join Snowy in the fish tank.
