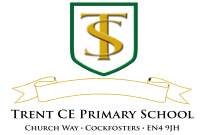

"I was really grateful for joining Alvaro in collecting plastic around the school for recycling"

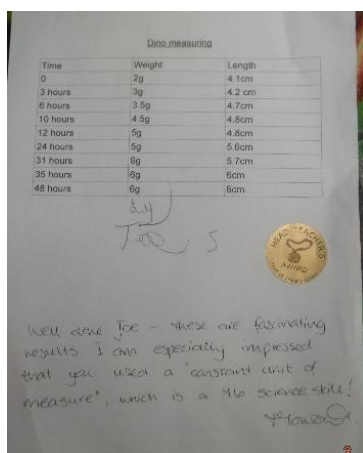
Doodle Maths
